With recent changes approved by the Board of Trustees, you now get even more from your benefits! And some of your enhanced Plan A benefits are retroactive. If you've already paid out of pocket for care that's covered retroactively, you can email your claim for reimbursement to contact@scufcwfunds.com. Be sure to include your name and Fund ID.

Sink Your Teeth Into These Dental Upgrades

On January 1, 2023, the yearly Indemnity Dental Plan benefit maximum will increase to \$2,000 for each person, age 19 and older, who is covered by the plan. Plus, you can carry over up to \$1,000 of unused dental benefits from 2022 into 2023!

And, as of April 1, 2022, the plan will provide coverage for dental implants. The plan will pay 70% of the scheduled allowance for dental implants that are medically and/or dentally necessary.

See How Your Vision Benefit Increased

On January 1, 2023, the annual Vision Care benefit maximum will increase to \$200, which helps pay for your eye exam, glasses, or contacts. Plus, you can carry over up to \$100 of your unused vision benefits from 2022 into 2023!

New Disability Extension Coverage

Effective May 1, 2022, if you're an eligible and enrolled Gold or Silver participant, you can receive up to six months disability extension if you meet the requirements to qualify.

Courtesy Clerks: Your New Lucky Number Is 13

Effective August 1, 2022, you'll become eligible for benefits as of your 13th month of employment, when you work the qualifying hours in the 11th month of your employment. If you've already worked 13 or more months, you're eligible to enroll for benefits. You'll need to fill out the required enrollment documents to receive your benefits. Watch for the packet from the Fund inviting you to enroll. Alternatively, visit the Fund's website to register for a personal portal, and then enroll online. Call the Fund Office if you need help.
